Old News:

- April minutes have been approved.

Financial Update:

- Tax exempt status still needs to be renewed; deadline is mid-May for submission. Finance committee will take care of this initiative.
- YTD financials and 2022 budget need to be updated by finance committee and sent to the whole steering committee by 5/15.

Volunteer Day:

- Hicks soil will be delivered on Saturday morning. Future discussion to be had on where we order soil amendments in the future given the pricing and delivery charges from Hicks.
- Plants for plant sale to be picked up on Friday prior to volunteer day and will be priced out on Friday evening.
- Email sent out to key holders to volunteer; Front and back bed gardeners have been notified and several have committed to volunteer and lead volunteer efforts.
- 200 new keys have been ordered, 100 will be guaranteed available for Friday to be prepared for key sales on Saturday.
- Plan for soil amendment delivery discussed and will attempt to avoid putting soil in the front gazebo. Key sales and plant sale will be held concurrently.

Misc Business
